Professor Recommendation: All applicants for the Reading Choral Society College Choral Singer Scholarship must submit a written recommendation from a professor. Recommending professor must be a current vocal/choral professor of the applicant at his/her attending college/university.

Recommendations must address the following questions to the best of the professor's ability.

- In what classes/ensembles have you taught/supervised the applicant?
- What is the level of performance that the applicant has achieved while participating in your class/ensemble?
- Does the applicant show leadership in a choral ensemble setting? If so, please explain.
- Please describe the applicant's current areas of strength and areas that can continue to be strengthened over the remainder of their collegiate study.
- Please include any additional information you would like us to know about the student.

Submission Requirements:

- Please include a cover page including the following information: Professor's name, institution, position, academic relationship to student.
