- *What is the level of performance that the applicant has achieved while participating in your class/ensemble?*
- *Does the applicant show leadership in a choral ensemble setting? If so, please explain.*
- *Please describe the applicant's current areas of strength and areas that can continue to be strengthened over the remainder of their collegiate study.*
- *Please include any additional information you would like us to know about the student.*
